## **Arts and Athletics Club Production Covid-19 Protocols**

*Updated 9/11/2021*

Arts and Athletics Club is constantly working and reworking its plan to provide theater to the community during this pandemic. Community safety is our main priority and we are excited to be able to create an environment of creativity while we get out of this pandemic. Due to the prevalence of the Delta Variant, we will continue our health and safety plan. Here is a look at our strategy moving forward.

### **Covid-19 Safety Precautions**

- Participants will wear a mask during rehearsals and face shield during performance. This production has participants as young as 10, therefore not everyone in the cast has had the opportunity to be vaccinated. We will retain our face mask policy for this production.
- Since we are rehearsing at parks, we must follow any additional rules the parks set in place. Arts and Athletics Club will also do their part and wipe off any surfaces prior and post rehearsal. Some parks may also close their restroom facilities due to Covid, so please plan accordingly.
- Cast and crew members are asked to self-screen before each rehearsal. If any one is showing signs of Covid-19 including, but not limited to: coughing, sore throat, headaches, fever, loss of taste or smell, they are asked to notify the director that they will not be able to attend rehearsal.
- Rehearsal will be held outside. Because this performance is taking place in October, we may have chilly rehearsal days. Please prepare accordingly.
- Due to rehearsals being outside, in the event of rain or other weather emergency, all cast and crew members will be notified and rehearsal will be moved to a virtual zoom rehearsal or cancelled.
- Rain dates will be set for performances.
- Props and costumes will be separated by actor to avoid unnecessary touching of other people's materials. Costumes will mostly be self-provided.
